All of our flooring is recycled material salvaged from antique buildings 100 to 200 years old. Our flooring is full of character and rich patina. No two floors are exactly alike. The flooring character includes worm holes, nail holes, knot holes, weather cracks, and a range of colors.

*Boards are available in tongue-and-groove and/or straight-edge cuts, depending on species.
We can mill moldings and stair treads to go along with your floors.*



Antique American Chestnut Wide Plank

Our most popular floor with full character and patina.
Worm holes, nail holes, knots and medium to dark color.



Antique American Chestnut Remilled

Cut from antique beams, with characteristic worm holes and some nail holes.
Light to medium in color. Not as rustic as the wide plank chestnut.



Antique Oak Wide Plank

Full character and patina. Our hardest floor, great for heavy wear.
Characteristic flake patterns throughout.



Antique Oak Remilled

Cut from antique beams. Light to medium patina.
Not as rustic as wide plank oak.



Antique Old Growth Eastern White Pine Wide Plank

Warm honey patina. Softer than oak or chestnut.
Look and feel of the most traditional wide pine floor. Full character.



Antique Old Growth Heart Pine

Noticeable grain pattern. Full character. Heart pine is a beautiful tight grained wood.
Although classified as a "softwood" it is extremely hard and durable.
Heart pine is cut from antique timbers.
